# **2023 Quilting Camp Project Summary**

### Beginner's Appliqué Project Options

Teddy Bear or Horse Appliqué -- create a small wall quilt or turn your work into a fun pillow cover. Teddy Bear finishes at 12" x 12" and the Horse at 12" x 16". You will learn the fundamentals of fusible appliqué.

One more fun appliqué option is our Scalloped Sunflower Tabletop Quilt. From the fundamentals of fusible appliqué -- you'll also learn the magic in making this quilt top that will be finished without needing additional quilting and binding.

Top finishes at approximately 18" diameter.

## Intermediate Appliqué Project Options:

Create a fun wall or lap quilt with some cute pets or a wall quilt or pillow cover or a rainbow unicorn. In addition to appliqué fundamentals – you will also do a little piecing – especially with the Pets project. Pets project finishes at 29" x 29" and the unicorn is 14" x 20".

## **Foundation Paper Piecing Projects**

This is a technique that allows you to create images and shapes that can be challenging using traditional patchwork. Beginners will create 4 blocks that are holiday themed and join them to create a fun wall quilt. Your quilt will finish at 26" x 26"

More skilled or adventurous quilt makers can select the Butterflies Wall Hanging – you'll piece 3 slightly different butterflies and then join them together for a fun wall quilt/banner. This project finishes at 13" x 35"

### **Traditionally Pieced Quilt Projects**

For true beginners we have selected a pattern that looks far more complicated than it is! You'll create your striped blocks and then join them to your solid blocks to create rows ... then sew your rows together. Add a border around your project and you are ready to quilt! Project finishes at 34" x 34"




For more experienced quilt makers we have two options. The first is a large 1 block quilt comprised of solid squares and half-square triangle (HST) blocks. You'll learn the short cut technique for making the HST blocks and then you'll get organized and sew them into your quilt top. A border frames your work. Project finishes at 20" x 20" -- so make it a wall quilt, tabletop quilt or a pillow cover!

Traditional pieced Project #2

For our truly experienced quiltmakers – we will teach you how to make 3 different blocks – a Churn Dash block, a Friendship Star block and a Variable Star Block. Using both Half Square Triangles and Quarter Square Triangles – you'll learn a variety of techniques to begin filling your quilt making tool box.

Your project finishes at 33" x 33".
