Exhibition Day Judging Criteria

Texas Cultural Arts Exhibit Categories

Originality 12 points

Workmanship 10 points

Workmanship 12 points (Evenness of all stitches and ends concealed, etc.)

Exhibition Day Entry Classes, Awards & Rules:

Texas Cultural Arts Exhibit Categories:

Rules – Cultural Arts Exhibit

1. Only Texas Extension Education Association members are eligible to enter the exhibit categories. TEEA members are those who have paid state dues in a timely manner. Dues must be paid before entering on any level.
2. Kits will be allowed.
3. Only one item per person may be entered in each category. If it is a set – limited to 4 pieces (Example: Jewelry – ring, bracelet, necklace, earrings)
4. Each county will hold its own elimination and may send the first and second place winners in each category to district competition.
5. Each district may enter only the first place winner in each category for state competition.
6. Each article must be the work of the TEEA member or members, if applicable, displaying the work, said work completed during the past year.
7. For District competition-Type or print the description of each article on the TEEA Cultural Arts Form (sample form on page 6-34; forms for duplication on page 6-35 download form from TEEA website Forms tab)), and attach the form to article. Entries will not be accepted unless this information is already attached at the time the item is checked in for district competition. The County Association Chair and the District Director must sign this form.
8. For State competition, District Directors should send a list of Cultural Arts District Winners to the Host District Cultural Arts Exhibit Chair following district competition.
9. Each winner is responsible for getting exhibits to and from the state conference site.
10. Each winner should provide their own materials to exhibit the articles. Tape and nails cannot be used on the walls.
11. Entries will be exhibited by category.
12. Neither the district nor the state will be responsible for any lost, misplaced, or broken items. We do not anticipate any misfortunes, but this disclaimer must be clearly understood by all exhibitors.
13. Hostesses will be on duty at all times.
14. Each entry must be judged at the state level in the same category it was judged at the county and district levels.
15. Judges will judge entries in each category and award a first and a second place ribbon. If the judges should decide that no entry deserves a ribbon, they have the option to award no ribbons.
16. Judges will consider the criteria on the Cultural Arts Judging Score Card.
17. Best of Show item will be selected by the judges from the first place winners at the State Conference Cultural Arts Exhibit.
18. The County Association Chair will complete the Cultural Arts Winners form for Counties and send to the District Director 30 days prior to the District contest.

Exhibition Day Entry Classes, Awards & Rules Cont.:

NON Cultural Arts Exhibit Rules (categories 31-71)

- May enter more than one item in any given category (categories 31-71 only).
- These items do not advance to District.
- All items in categories 36-71 *must have 1 printed copy of the recipe* submitted with entry form.
- Items in categories 31-35 will not be tasted by the judges. Items in these categories will be judged on appearance only.
- All canned goods must be in standard half-pint, pint, or quart mason jars with self-sealing lids. Do not remove rings.

Open Class:

- Anyone that is not a paid TEEA member or not a 4-H member may enter All categories.
- Judging will be each on its own merit.
- A first, second or third place ribbon will be awarded to each item depending on judges score.
- Entries in this class will not advance to district or state.
- Kits WILL be allowed

4-H Class:

- Anyone that is a paid 4-H member may enter All Categories.
- A first, second or third place ribbon will be awarded to each item depending on judges score.
- Entries in this class will not advance to district or state.
- Kits WILL be allowed

***ALL CLASS entries must have a completed Williamson County Exhibition Day Entry form.** A copy of the form can be found at the back of this yearbook for your convenience.

You will need one entry form for each item and must have been made the project within the last year.

TEXAS Cultural Arts Exhibit Categories

Williamson County Arts & Crafts I Division

- 1.A. Afghans, Tablecloths, Bedspreads, Blankets, and Throws – made with yarn
- 1.B. Afghans, Tablecloths, Bedspreads, Blankets, and Throws – made with crochet thread (cotton or thinner than yarn)
2. Ceramics, China, Porcelain, and Pottery
3. Craft Painting – tole and decorative, stenciling – may include wood, metal, glass, fabric, and gourds
4. Decorated Garments and Accessories – Purchased-embellished or decorated with fabric, ribbon, trim, stones, and/or lace (clothing and accessories)
5. Garments and Accessories – Handmade or Sewn
6. Fabric Creations – (must be made of fabric) – may include dolls, animals, baskets, pillows, braided rugs, door stops, crocheted rag-rugs, etc.
7. Fiber Arts – crocheting, knitting, tatting, macrame, and spinning – may include clothing, doilies, scarfs, and other small items

8. Needlework – needlepoint, crewel, embroidery, candle wicking, smocking, and counted cross-stitch
9. Machine Embroidery
10. Any Holiday or Seasonal Decoration – any holiday, any medium
11. Jewelry – may include beads, clay, paper, shells, stones, watercolor, glass, and wood
- 12 A-1. Painting – Oils
- 12 A-2. Painting – Watercolors
- 12 A-3. Painting – All Other
- 12 B-1. Drawing – Pencil
- 12 B-2. Drawing – Charcoal
- 12 B-3. Drawing – All other
13. Paper – may include note cards and pages
14. Traditional Scrapbooks (handmade)
15. Digitally Produced Scrapbooks (Computer – Butterfly, Creative Memories, etc.)
16. Photography – photo paper – black and white
17. Photography – photo paper – color
18. Photography – any other medium (canvas, glass, wood, and fiber — no larger than 16×20)

19. Quilts – smaller than 50×70 – Hand Quilted
20. Quilts – 50×70 or larger – Hand Quilted
21. Quilts – smaller than 50×70 – Machine Quilted
22. Quilts – 50×70 or larger – Machine Quilted
- 23.A. Quilts Twin Size or larger – Hand Quilted – constructed and quilted by two or more members
- 23.B. Quilts Twin Size or larger – Machine Quilted – constructed & quilted by two or more members
24. Quilts, appliqued by hand – smaller than 50×70
25. Quilts, appliqued by hand – 50×70 or larger
26. Quilts, appliqued by machine – smaller than 50×70
27. Quilts, appliqued by machine – 50×70 or larger
- 28.A. Wall Hanging – Quilted
- 28.B. Wall Hanging – Not Quilted
29. Recycled Items – any medium
30. Miscellaneous (items that do not fit any previous category)
