



Wayne Rhoden Memorial Scholarship

Williamson County Master Gardener Association is awarding scholarships to outstanding 4-H members in Williamson County.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

- There will be three scholarships awarded in the amount of \$1000 each.

ELIGIBILITY OF APPLICANT

To be eligible, a student must:

- Be an active member and enrolled in 4-H for a minimum of 3 years.
- Be a current member of Williamson County 4-H for their senior year of high school.
- Be a graduate of high school in the 2023-2024 school year.
- Intend to enroll full-time in a college, university, or technical school in the Fall of 2024.
- Letters of recommendation from 4-H leader, community or school leader
- Submit the completed application and attachments and return by April 15th.

IF SELECTED, SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- Mail a thank you note by August 31, 2024.
- Before receiving a scholarship, the recipient must submit proof of school registration, student ID number, name and address of the financial aid office/director at the school they will be attending. These items must be submitted no later than August 1, 2024. All scholarship monies will be mailed directly to the financial aid office and will be distributed through them. Any monies left over or refunded will remain in the student's scholarship account at school or be returned to Wayne Rhoden Memorial Scholarships in care of Williamson County Master Gardener Association scholarships.
- Students must be enrolled as full-time students in a college, university, or technical school. Full-time is defined at 12 hours per semester (or technical school equivalent).
