- ✓ Minimum 2.5 GPA or higher
- ✓ Must submit completed application February 1, 2026-~~March 31, 2026~~

Recipient must submit proof of school registration, social security number, name, and address of financial aid office/director at the school they will be attending. Submit these items within 30 days prior to recipient needing the scholarship.

Scholarship awards must be used in the 2026-2027 academic year.

Scholarship Mission Statement

The Williamson County Farm Bureau is awarding several academic scholarships to deserving candidates enrolled in college, trade or technical institutions.

Eligibility Criteria

Scholarships will be awarded to deserving candidates who are attending college or technical schools during the 2026-2027 academic year. Applications will be available on **February 1, 2026**, and must be received by **April 30, 2026**. Any interviews required will be scheduled shortly thereafter.

10 scholarships at \$1000 (minimum) each will be awarded.

Rules for Eligibility include:

- Must be a graduating HS senior, or an enrolled college or technical school student,
- Must be a member, child of or under legal guardianship of a current Williamson County Farm Bureau member in good standing. New members are welcome to apply,
- Must have an equivalent of a cumulative 2.5 grade point average,
- May be subjected to a formal interview process with members of the scholarship committee or designate,
- Must utilize awarded funds during the 2026-2027 academic year.

Before receiving a scholarship, recipient must submit proof of school registration, social security number, name, and address of financial aid office/director at the school they will be attending. Submit these items within 30 days prior to recipient needing the scholarship. All scholarship funds will be mailed directly to the financial aid office and will be distributed directly through them. Any monies left over or refunded will remain in the student's scholarship account at school or be returned to the WCFB.
