		Attendance – County Council Officers should attend county-level events as representatives from the Council. Attendance is required at County Council meetings ; if an officer misses more than 2 meetings (out of the 4 bi-monthly meetings), they will be <i>subject to review and may be removed from the Williamson County Council for the current year.</i>
		Participation – County Council Officers are expected to lead by example in participating in activities, or volunteering to help with activities, whenever possible. This includes but is not limited to: involvement in county-wide fundraisers through participation, planning, or promotion, volunteering in (not just participating in) county-wide events like One Day 4-H, County Contests, Awards Banquet, and others. Being an officer is a year-long commitment.
		Communication and Conflicts – County Council Officers should communicate in advance when they have conflicts. Officers should communicate (via email, text, or call) with the 4-H County Extension Agent if they will be late or miss an event.
		Understanding of Requirements – Officers that do not complete these requirements or uphold the duties of their office during the year will be subject to review and may be removed from the Williamson County Council for the current year. Any officers removed from their position will forfeit their title for the current year (including in recordbooks and applications) and forfeit the opportunity to run for County Council the following year.
